

IF YOUR PARTNER(S) IS INFECTED CONDOMS ARE DANGEROUS

A lot of people have a great trust in condoms in order to avoid HIV virus infection. They are sure or confident that if they wear condoms while having sex, nothing happens to them. However this is not true. Besides the fact that condoms are immoral, condoms are also very dangerous. In fact:

1. **If your partner is infected, or if some of your partners are infected,** you will catch HIV virus in a short while. The reason is that in one year time you can not avoid some of the following facts, and it is sufficient it happens just once in order to catch HIV virus:
 - A. Condoms will break. In fact condoms have a very high percentage of breakage (36% of those using condoms experience breakage in USA)
 - B. Condoms will slip away. In fact condoms have a still higher percentage of slippage (44% in USA).
 - C. You might buy a condom that is not suitable to your penis, with unforeseen consequences of breakage and slippage. In USA 50% of those using condoms are used to make such a mistake.
 - D. You are not able to follow all the instructions in order to use condoms correctly. Do you know what are they? Here are the instructions given by SIECUS in USA:
 - “A new condom is used every time a person has sexual intercourse.
 - The condom is put on after the penis is erect and before it touches any part of partner's mouth, anus, or vagina.
 - If the condom breaks during sexual intercourse, the penis should be withdrawn immediately, and a new condom should be put on the penis.
 - Withdraw from the partner immediately after ejaculation, holding the condom firmly to the base of the penis to keep it from slipping off, so no semen is spilled.
 - Water-based lubrication should be used to prevent condoms from breaking; oil-based lubricants such as cooking or vegetable oils, baby oil, hand lotion, or petroleum jelly should never be used with latex condoms. They can cause the condom to break.
 - Condoms should be stored in a drawer or closet, somewhere cool, dry, and out of direct sunlight. Changes in temperature, rough handling or age can make the latex brittle or gummy. Never use condoms that are damaged or discolored, brittle, or sticky. Do not store them in a wallet or car glove compartment for a long time.”

 - E. To avoid HIV virus it is necessary to use condoms all the times you have sex. However very hardly you will be able to always use condoms? In fact in USA 83% of those using condoms are not using it consistently. Do you know why? Here we have some reasons reported by the people in USA:
 - 'I can't find one that fits.'

- 'Sex doesn't feel as good.'
 - 'Condoms cut off my circulation.'
 - 'I forgot to bring it'
 - 'I forgot to buy it'
 - It is unpleasant to wear condoms
- F. You might buy condoms which are not suitable to stop HIV Virus. In order to make money your condoms seller might advise you that any condoms are suitable to stop HIV virus, instead they are not: latex condoms only are suitable to stop HIV Virus.
- G. You might buy condoms that are defective. Just for your knowledge the USA are powerless so far against those firms smuggling defective condoms into them.
- H. You might use condoms with spermicides, because they convince you that such condoms are much more effective. Instead condoms with spermicides are spreading rather than stopping AIDS.
- I. When you are used to have sex, you will have sex at any cost, even though condoms are not available or are not suitable to you, or are already used., or are already damaged.
- J. You will find impossible to always withdraw immediately after ejaculation.

CONCLUSION: if by chance your partner is already affected by HIV Virus and you make only one mistake, you are finished. The only solution is to be *faithful to your spouse* if you are married, and to be *chaste (or abstinent)* if you are not married.

Do not forget: if you use condoms, you are not protected from catching other sexual transmitted Diseases.

CONDOM IS IMMORAL:

- **Married people can not use condoms, because they can not misuse the power to give life they received from God.**
- **Married people can not use condoms outside marriage, because God said” “You can not commit adultery.”**
- **Single people can not used condoms, because God said also to them: “Yu can not commit adultery.”**
